- For Admission in MS/MPhil/MSc (Hons), candidates must secure at least 50% marks in the Screening Test conducted by the University OR must have valid GRE/HAT General/Equivalent tests, with a passing score of 50%.
- The condition of a minimum of 120 credit hours will apply to a Master's degree/4-year degree awarded after intermediate/equivalent as the required qualification for admission to the MS/MPhil/M.Sc. (Hons) program.
